

AICP GENERAL INFORMATION

To become a certified planner and use the AICP designation, one must be a current member of the American Planning Association, submit an application meeting certain education and experience requirements, pass an examination, and be a fully paid member of APA and AICP.

November 2010 application and fee submission deadline: Please continue to check APA at <http://www.planning.org/certification/2010/nov/index.htm> for application deadline.

Beginning with the 2005 exam cycle, AICP introduced a new application that combines the application and registration steps into one form and one fee. Education and employment verifications for each degree and job listed in the application will continue to be required in order for your application to be considered complete for review. The application fee is \$60 and the exam fee is \$425.

Candidates whose applications are approved will receive an Authorization to Test via e-mail. This will contain instructions for how to set up your exam appointment during the testing window.

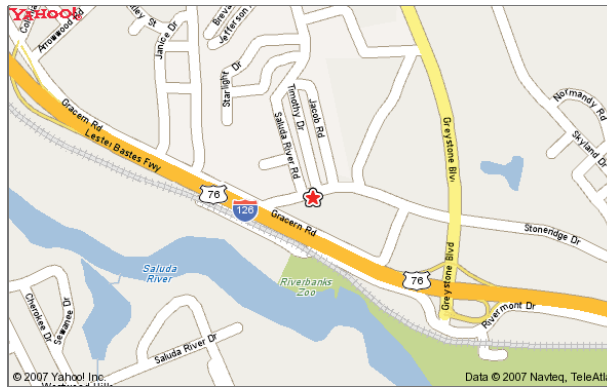
Exam takers will receive their test results before they leave the testing center.

DIRECTIONS
